

What is the GDPR?



- The GDPR replaces the Data Protection Act (DPA) 1988 (amended in 2003).
- Same basic principles as the current Data Protection law but strengthened.
 - Transparency
 - Purpose Limitation
 - Data Minimisation
 - Accuracy
 - Storage Limitation
 - Integrity and Confidentiality
 - Accountability Evidence of Compliance through process & documentation.
- Empowers the consumer with new rights and more control over their data.
- Higher penalties for non compliance.

Impact on Law Firms




Where does Keyhouse fit in?

File Closing Procedure


Should already be familiar with this —

Ensure:

- all balances are nil,
- all time is posted to the ledger
- Tasks in the Case Diary are marked as complete
- No undischarged Undertakings



File Closing Procedure - Destroy Date



To close a matter, go to Case Details, Archive and tick the box marked Closed.

Storage Limitation

"Personal Data shall be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed"

Complete & Accurate data entry and a File Closing procedure is vital for reporting on Data that can be and should be deleted.

Greater Controls for Data Subjects

- Right to be forgotten also known as Data Erasure
- Right to Access
- Data Portability
- Privacy by Design



Data Erasure – Right to be Forgotten


GDPR provides individuals with broader rights to have their data erased without undue delay:

"Where the personal data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was collected"




GDPR Keyhouse Functionality Erasing/Purging Data

- ➤ Must be logged in as an administrator
- ➤ In System Configuration Enable Destroy Matter must be ticked.






Destroy Matter Wizard – Step 1






Destroy Matter Wizard – Step 2






Destroy Matter Wizard – Step 3




Where to start? - Data Cleansing Tip

Dormant Matters Report will identify matters/cases which could have been closed but have remained open.



Any such matters should be closed and their destroy dates set as soon as possible.

Subject Access Requests

What information is an individual entitled to under the GDPR?

- purpose of processing.
- access to their personal data; and
- other supplementary information largely corresponds to the information that should be provided in a privacy notice.



Keyhouse GDPR Functionality - SARs


- ➤ Use existing Keyhouse Functionality to build a precedent document (SAR Template) with UDFs for the required fields and pre populated paragraphs outlining privacy notices.
- > Option to gather client data in a form when opening a file.

➤ Use Document Manager to export personal data and documentation to a "commonly used machine-readable format" i.e. Word/Excel/PDF.







THE RIGHT TO DATA PORTABILITY UNDER THE GDPR





Article 20 of the GDPR creates a new right to data portability, which is closely related to the right of access but differs from it in many ways. It allows for data subjects to receive the personal data that they have provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to transmit those data to another data controller.




Data Portability

The new right to data portability enables individuals to obtain their data and move it to another controller without hindrance.

Only applies to personal data an individual has provided to a controller and not data generated by the controller.

Data Privacy by Design & by Default

Has existed for years but only just becoming a legal requirement as part of the GDPR now.

Aims to establish a new culture of privacy by design and by default, by requiring data privacy to be embedded into a business.



Data Privacy by Design & by Default


Privacy by design:

Data protection to be included from the beginning and not "an after thought".

Privacy by default:

Ensure that by default, personal data is processed only for the specific purpose for which it was obtained and access to personal data is limited to only those resources needed to carry out the processing of the case.



How does the Record Security Module work?

- Users are assigned to record security groups and the same security group are assigned to Client/Matters.


